DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Dogs who are at least 1 year of age are eligible to take the ATT and must either be AKC or FSS registered or listed with Canine Partners or have a Purebred Alternative Listing number. Dogs that are spayed or neutered may participate. Dogs must be able to perform whole categories of the test (such as hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), in order to be eligible to earn an ATT title. Dogs with disabilities such as those that are blind, deaf, or have three legs are eligible to enter provided in the opinion of the evaluator they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test.

However, if a dog has multiple disabilities such that, it is unable to complete whole categories of the test (i.e. - hearing auditory stimuli and seeing visual stimuli), the dog would not earn the ATT title. Dogs may wear slip collars that are on the dead ring, buckle collars, martingales and body harnesses in the ATT. They may not wear prong collars, head collars, e-collars, or harnesses that restrict the movement of the dog. Leashes should be 4ft. to 6ft. long and should be made of fabric or leather. Females in season (heat) may not participate.

ENTRY FEES

No PRE-entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

SIGN-IN/ARRIVAL & CRATING AREA

There will be a table and trial steward for check-ins and information. When you arrive at the Temperament tests, you will check in and receive your information on run time. This is a walk-up style event. When you are ready to trial your dog in our Temperament tests, you will be put in the running order. No running order will be made prior to the day of the shows. If you are not present when your name is called for your run/you have a conflict, your name will be placed towards the end of the running order & we will work you back in.

Dogs will be crated or lined up out of view of the ATT test area, or far enough away as to not cause a distraction to the dog being tested. We encourage you to crate from your cars or under cover (canopy) nearby.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal trashcans will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Please don't let us lose our show site because of not picking up dog poop. We want to be respectful of the Posey County Fairgrounds! See our Treasurer the day of show for a fun incentive to keeping our show site clean! Exhibitors should also follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ABOUT THE ATT (Temperament) TEST

The AKC Temperament Test (ATT) is a general temperament test for all breeds and mixed breed dogs that will assess the dog's reaction to a variety of stimulus. These stimuli will be in the following six categories: Social, Auditory, Visual, Tactile (touch), Proprioceptive (motion) and Unexpected Stimuli. The purpose of the ATT is to test for fear, shyness, inability to recover, and lack of cooperation. Desired traits are that the dog will be emotionally stable, inquisitive, appropriately social for its breed, biddable, and demonstrates the ability to recover from a startling situation in a reasonable amount of time. Dogs who show signs of aggression will not pass the test. One purpose of the ATT is to educate dog owners about the temperament of their breeds. At each test, in addition to a title application form and their contact information on the evaluator's checklist, handlers complete the form labeled, "Your Breed's Temperament." The form includes a space for the handlers of mixed-breed dogs to write about the temperament of their individual dogs. Clubs are required to print the Breed Temperament Guide <https://www.akc.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/07/breed-temperament-guide-akc-fss-July2021.pdf> and have copies on the registration. The ATT is a non-competitive pass-fail test. In a test, a dog must pass 3 test items in each of these categories (total of 18 test items). These are selected from a list of 24 possible test items. All dogs who pass the ATT twice under two different approved ATT Evaluators may earn the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) Title.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR & LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this test, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all tasks within safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Evansville Obedience Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Evansville Obedience Club has the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Evansville Obedience Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar during testing. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane. No flexi-type leashes will be allowed on site or during the test.

REFUNDS

If an ATT Test in this premium is cancelled, the Evansville Obedience Club will contact any preregistered entrants. The Evansville Obedience Club will communicate the change to any potential entrants by the method which they originally advertised to those potential entrants. If the Evansville Obedience Club cancels the ATT test, preregistered entrants will be given a refund for their entry fees. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are not eligible for a refund. Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
